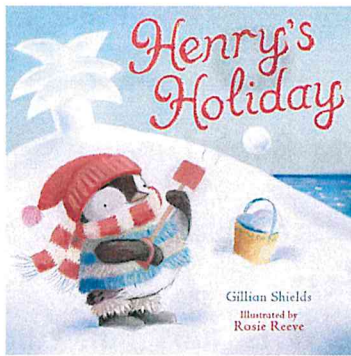
Year 5 & 6

Our current topic is the Rainforest and keeping with this theme we would like the children to use their imagination to dress up inspired by the Rainforest.



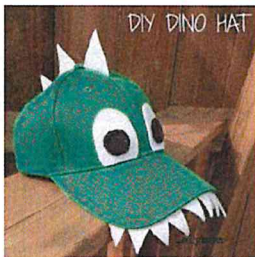

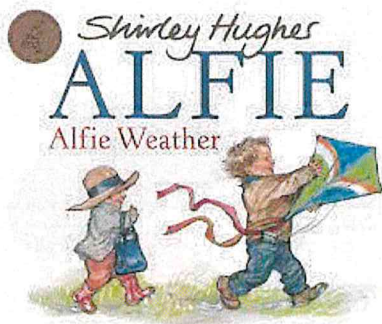
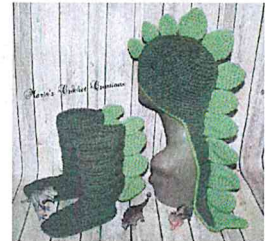


THIS IS THE BOOK THE CHILDREN IN NURSERY HAVE BEEN READING.
