Are they taller or shorter than you?</p>	<p>Could you have a try at growing something? Maybe plant some cress and then watch it grow! Could you write a label for your plant?</p>
<p>Go on a leaf hunt outside. Can you find a big and a small leaf? Maybe try and find 5 and put them into size order.</p>	<p>Learn the nursery rhyme 'Mary, Mary quite contrary'.
