Listen to the story of 'Jasper's Beanstalk' online. Which is your favourite part? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=SRE88_fu0rs	Create your own beanstalk using things from around your house e.g. old boxes, bottles and cardboard tubes. How tall can you make it?	What can you see growing either in your garden or on a walk close to your house? Can you draw a picture of it?
Draw a picture to show what you think would be at the top of Jasper's beanstalk.	Cut out some paper beans. Roll a dice - can you count out the right number of beans?	Jasper does things on different days of the week. Can you learn the days of the week? Dance and clap along to a days of the week song! Jasper planted 6 beans but he got fed up and dug 2 beans up. How many were left to grow? Can you solve any other questions like this? You could draw a picture or use your fingers to help you.	Can you measure yourself using socks? How tall are you? Can you measure someone else? Are they taller or shorter than you?	Could you have a try at growing something? Maybe plant some cress and then watch it grow! Could you write a label for your plant?
Go on a leaf hunt outside. Can you find a big and a small leaf? Maybe try and find 5 and put them into size order.	Learn the nursery rhyme 'Mary, Mary quite contrary'.
