This term the older children would have been focussing more on writing letters and numbers, putting sounds together to make words and using written numbers to record how many. 	Sound of the day	Number of the day	Shape of the day
Monday	<b>S</b> Say the sound, say words, beginning with 's', write 's' in the air, on paper.	<b>1</b> Look around and outside. Where can you see '1'. Write a numeral 1.	<b>Circle</b> Look around and talk about the circle shaped objects you can see.
Tuesday	<b>S</b> Make a collection of and draw 's' objects, think of words that begin with 's' and play I Spy.	<b>2</b> Look around and outside. Where can you see a numeral 2? Trace over or write a numeral 2.	<b>Circle</b> Practise drawing circles. Draw a big circle and turn it into an object.
Wednesday	<b>a</b> Say the sound, say words, beginning with 'a', write 'a' in the air, on paper.	<b>1 and 2</b> Roll a dice. Can you jump, hop, roll, clap one or two times.	<b>Square</b> Look around and talk about the square shaped objects you can see.
Thursday	<b>a</b> Make a collection of and draw 'a' objects, think of words that begin with 's' and play I Spy	<b>3</b> Look around and outside. Can you see a numeral 3? Trace over or write a numeral 3.	<b>Square</b> Draw squares. Draw a big square and turn it into an object.
Friday	<b>s, a</b> Sort the collection of 's' and 'a' objects.	<b>1,2,3</b> Roll a dice and collect 1,2,3 objects.	<b>Triangle</b> Look around and talk about the triangular shapes.
