

Shape, space and measure:

Collect some recycled containers of different shapes. What 3D shapes can you recognise? Can you make a model using the containers and then write a label for it?



Understanding the World:

Observe the weather each day and make a chart showing the information. Which day did the sun shine? Which day did it rain?



Reading:

Ask your grown up to write down some tricky words and hide them round your house. Can you find them and read them? Maybe you could then write a sentence using the words.

Art and Design:

Can you make a mask? Decorate it with things you have at home.



Communication and Language:

Make a phone using two yoghurt pots and a piece of string. Have a conversation with someone making sure you both talk and listen!



Writing:

Write someone you know a card or a little letter to let them know you are thinking about them.



People and Communities:

Can you begin to make a memory jar / box with your family to record this time? Maybe draw a picture of your family to put in?

Number:

Roll two dice and then add the numbers together. Can you write down the sums? Next pick a number from 10-20. Roll a dice and take that number away and write the sum. Use objects to help you if you need to.
