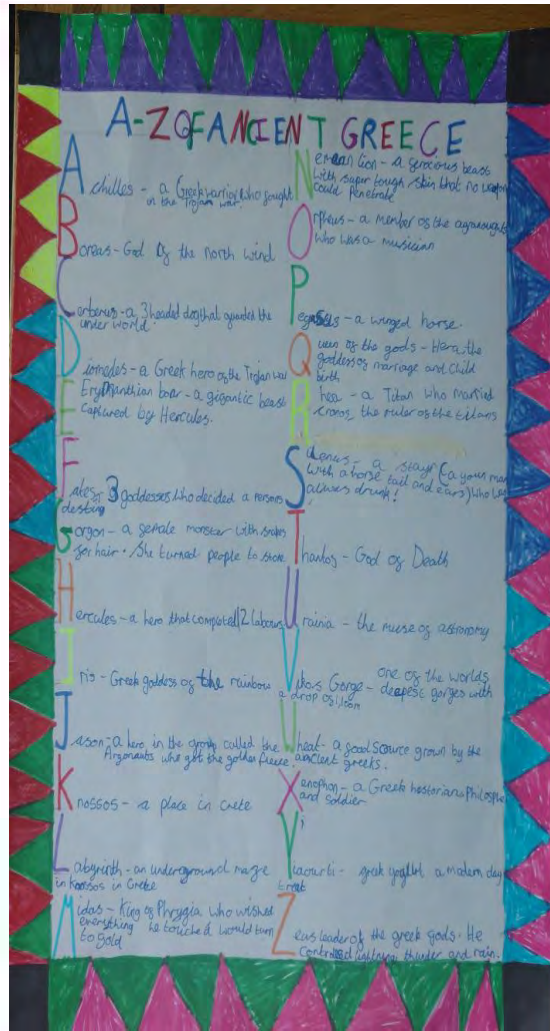

MATHEMATICIAN ARCHIMEDES RUNS NAKED IN THE STREET




Archimedes, the mathematician, was seen sprinting down the street shouting, "EUREKA! I GOT IT!"

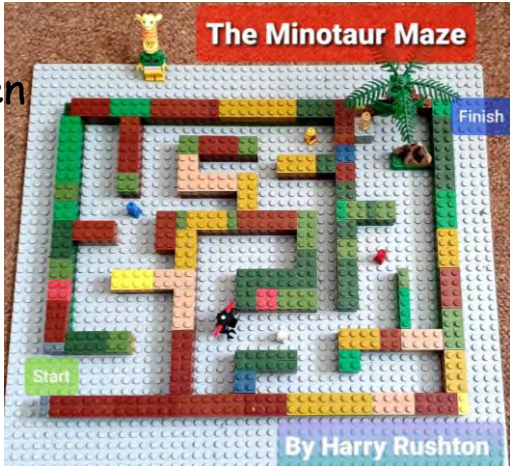

Liam has been finding out about Hercules's 12 labours

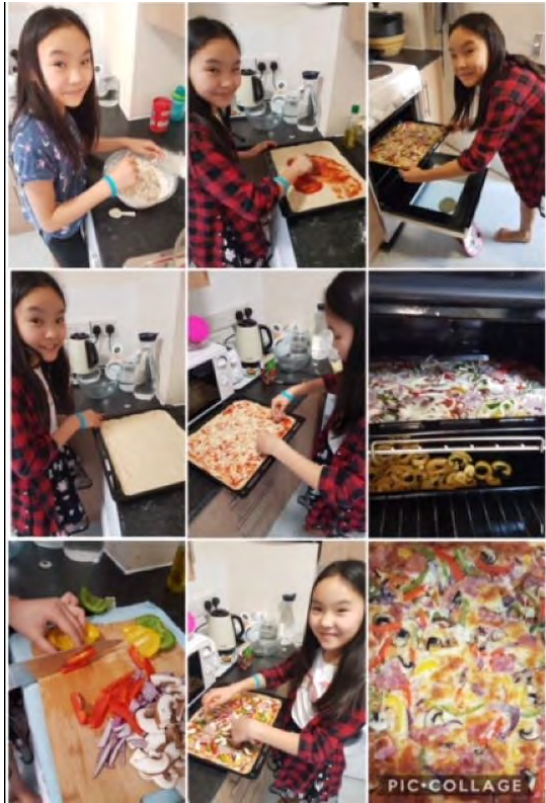
Don't mess with Liam!
