Can you write the sums underneath each one?</p>	<p>Look at the 'under the sea' picture. Can you write 2/3 sentences about the picture?</p>	<p>Can you make a mermaid? You could have a go at the split pin craft.</p>
<p>Do another floating and sinking experiment with different objects to last time. What do you predict will happen and what are the results?</p>	<p>Do a colour scavenger hunt when you are on a walk.</p> 	<p>Play a board game or complete a jigsaw.</p> 	<p>Make fairy cakes and decorate them!</p>
