Write a sentence for each of the sounds you have spotted.</p>	<p><b>Reading Comprehension</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Listen to the rest of the reading of the story 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' on You Tube.</li> </ul> <p>Think about Mr Gumpy's reply to the animals in the story. Predict what he might say to different animals. E.g. <i>The Kangaroo asked 'May I come?'</i>. <i>Mr Gumpy replied 'Yes but _____'.</i> Try a snake, a duck, an elephant, a parrot or a cheetah.</p>
<p><b>Maths – Money</b> After you have been shopping or had some shopping delivered, choose 6 different items each costing less than 50p. Make a price label for each one, e.g. 39p, 18p. Shuffle the labels. Try to spend some time each day trying one or more of the following activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Place the labels in order, starting with the lowest.</li> <li>• Say which price is an odd number and which is an even number.</li> <li>• Add 10p to each price in their head.</li> <li>• Take 5p from each price in their head.</li> <li>• Say which coins to use to pay exactly for each item.</li> <li>• Choose any two of the items, and find their total cost.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Science – Living and Not Living.</b> Compare yourself to a doll or teddy. How do we know if an object is living or not living? (growing, moving, using your senses, having babies, eating and drinking, going to the toilet).</p> <p>Make a list of the things the puppet can/ cannot do. Compare to a list of the things you can/ cannot do. What do our lists tell us?</p>	<p><b>Topic – History</b></p>  <p>This is Captain James Cook. Look at some pictures of him. What do you know from looking at the picture? What can you find out about him?</p>
