Draw a picture of each. Then write 2 things you have learned from the poems about each of the animals you have chosen.
<p>Maths – Position and Direction Think about a place where you like to walk (maybe the park, the beach, school). Draw a map of your journey to this place. Ask a grown up to follow your directions around the map. Remember to use your direction words – left, right, forwards, backwards, half turn, quarter turn.</p> <p>Practise some directions outside – give another family member directions to follow.</p>	<p>Science & Art (Outdoor Art) Nature Bugs – Using sticks, leaves and stones to make some amazing bugs. Spiders, butterflies, caterpillars, beetles, bees – the choice is yours! What will you create?</p> 	<p>Science Think carefully about the Nature Bug you have created. Can you find out about their habitat? Where do they live? Where will you be most likely to find the bug? What do they need in their habitat to survive? Draw and label a picture of their habitat.</p>
