Write 5 words for each of the sounds you have spotted. Practise reading the words by marching and using your arms. Write a sentence for each of the sounds you have spotted.</p>	<p>Reading Comprehension</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listen again to 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' on YouTube. <p>Pick out the 6 main events of the story. Split your paper into 6 sections, and write your own version of the story. Draw a picture and write a sentence for each part. Remember to include the beginning and the end.</p>
<p>Maths – Halving numbers. Recap halving shapes which we visited earlier in the year. Practise folding shapes in half using paper. Or maybe use food to practise cutting in half. Start with a number of an object e.g. sweets. Then investigate how we could share these between 2 children. This is then halving the number. Make sure both sides are equal, with the same amount on each side. Repeat with other starting numbers.</p>	<p>Science – Food Chains Talk about and write a definition for the words prey and predator. Watch the clip on BBC Bitesize: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/z96r82p</p> <p>Create some simple food chains together. Extend to learning about and creating a <u>food web</u>.</p>	<p>Topic – Geography Think about the places Captain Cook visited. Look together at maps of the world, or at a globe if you have access to one. Can you find the 7 continents? Also, the 5 oceans? (Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Arctic, Southern Oceans) Find out which animals live in the different continents/ oceans around the world. You could make an information poster or sheet.</p>

Make a booklet with some paper by folding a few pieces in half. You can create your own front cover too!</p>	<p>Art - Hokusai - clouds Find out and look at pictures using the Japanese cloud shapes. Talk about the swirls and how they are used to create the images. Practise drawing swirls to create clouds. Draw your own Hokusai picture. Use paint or pencils to add colour.</p> 	<p>Music – Sea Shanties As our topic is 'All at Sea', we will be learning to sing some Sea Shanties. This week's sea shanty is 'a local shanty about Redcar and the Zetland Lifeboat 'Come Along Brave Boys'.
