

ZPS Playtime and Lunchtime arrangements March 21

Morning Playtime

Each class (year group) will have a dedicated area for playtime, not used by other pupils at the same time.

This will also apply at lunchtime

Static play equipment will be available to the pupils (climbing equipment timetabled against the class who remain inside during dinner time) on a daily basis, and cleaned at the end of each day.

Pupils will be instructed by staff on the limits of their play area.

Staff from each class will supervise playtime each day (on a rota if numbers of children permit).

Where pupil numbers are low, children may play with balls, hoops and plastic skipping ropes but they must not share these between groups. Hand sanitization will be used as a protective measure.

Any play equipment used should be cleaned at the end of each day.

At playtime, the pupils may struggle to keep socially distant from each other, however staff should still reinforce this and encourage games that help children remain 2m from each other. Staff will have resources and ideas to support playtime activities in a more structured way to support social distancing.

Pupils will observe social distancing at the end of playtime, age appropriate and where practicable.

Pupils should enter school one at a time and wash their hands before entering the classroom.

EYFS will use their outdoor area for child directed outdoor play. There will be no set playtime for EYFS.
