Zetland Primary School – Lockdown Risk Assessment Review March 21

The lockdown risk assessment has been reviewed to incorporate interim procedures implemented to include measures taken to address the risk of coronavirus and Covid 19.

These measures are to align and work alongside the current lockdown procedures.

For the duration of the coronavirus procedures, internal classroom doors may be wedged open to facilitate the free movement throughout the school and reduce the risk of cross contamination from door handles etc.

All door wedges must be removed and all doors closed if the room is unoccupied for any period of time.

In the event of the lockdown alarm sounding, all staff, visitors and pupils are to stay in their allocated area.

Staff should close and secure all doors.

Staff will explain to pupils within their group, the arrangements for responding to a Lock down.
