Hands, Feet, Heart is a song written for children to celebrate and learn about South African Music.  This Unit of Work is focused around one song: Hands, Feet, Heart. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise different styles of South African music.  (See online Charanga planning tool for more information).	Up in the Air! In the Groove Charanga unit – an easy-to-learn song that demonstrates different styles of music.  This unit contains Listen & Appraise apps, Warm-up Games, Flexible Games, new progressive improvisation resources, and a new compose tool.  In the Groove is a song that was specially written for classroom use to teach children about different styles of music. This is a very easy song to learn and has been arranged in six different styles; Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. Each week you will listen and learn a different style of In The Groove.  In the Listen and Appraise section of this unit you will also listen to a well-known song in that week's style. Charanga Unit - Hey You! by Joanna Mangona - an Old-School Hip Hop tune written for children

This unit contains Listen & Appraise apps, new progressive Warm-up Games, Flexible Games, new progressive improvisation resources, and a new compose tool.

**Hey You!** is written in an Old-School Hip Hop style for children to learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.

As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other Old-School Hip Hop tunes.

Charanga Unit - Zootime

This unit contains Listen & Appraise apps, new progressive Warm-up Games, Flexible Games and new progressive improvisation resources.

All the learning is focused around one song: Zootime. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, the interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked.
