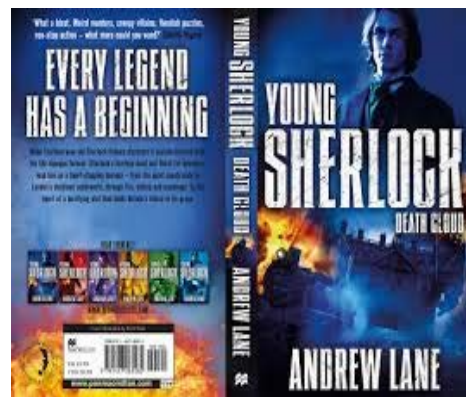
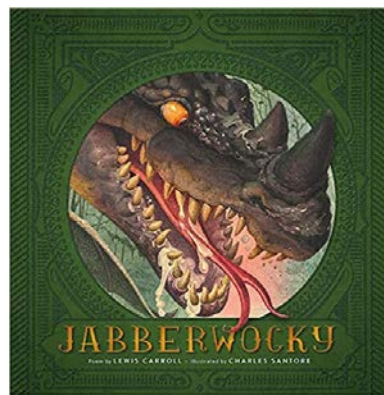
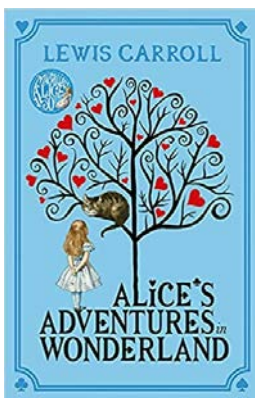


WHERE WILL YOUR READING TAKE YOU?

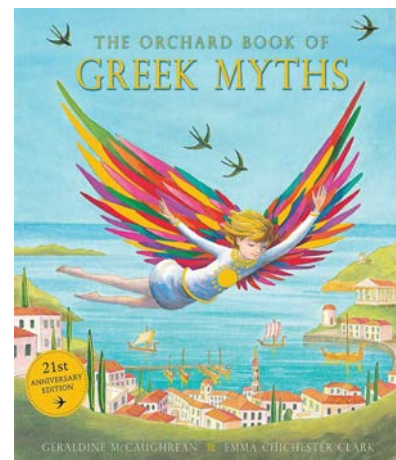
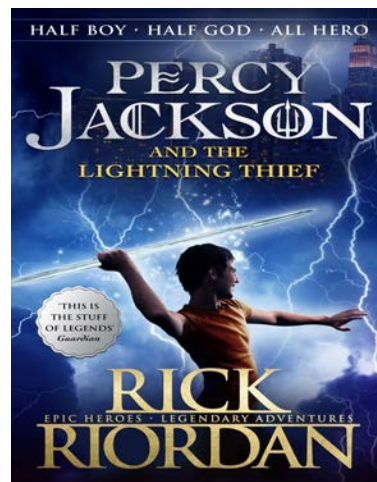
Cycle A

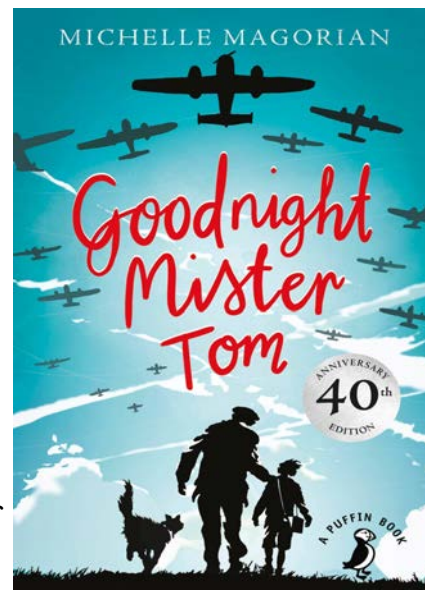
Cycle B
