In EYFS, pupils begin to understand their locality, the wider world, phenomena, such as the weather and seasons. We compare our locality to other localities, to compare the differences and similarities.	How is India different to Redcar? As part of our focus text of Elmer by David McKee, we will find out about India where elephants can be found living naturally in the wild.	How is winter different in Antarctica Redcar? We will begin exploring the season of winter by going on a winter walk around our school spotting signs of winter. We will spot and listen to the birds and make our own bird food to take home. We will then begin to look at Antarctica, using the atlas to locate. We will then use non-fiction books to find out about life in Antarctica, comparing how the winter is different here to Antarctica.	How can I get information from a map? We will look at simple maps of Redcar (paper based and Google Earth). We will point out familiar things on the map including our school, St Peter's Church, seaside and Zetland Park. We will then link this to the map in the story 'What the ladybird heard'. We will then draw our own simple maps, after completing a short walk, drawing 3 different landmarks we have seen on the way.
